

**MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY 24, 2014

President Nevin Scholl called to order the special meeting of Trappe Borough Council on February 24, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at Trappe Borough Hall, 525 West Main Street, Trappe, Pennsylvania. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Connie Peck.

President Scholl turned the meeting over to Vice-President C. Johnson.

**PROOF OF PUBLICATION:** J. Guenther submitted the Proof of Publication from the Mercury reflecting that the Special Meeting of the Trappe Borough Council, scheduled to take place on February 24, 2014, to discuss the proposed vertical banners on W. Main Street was advertised on February 13, 2014.

**VERTICAL BANNERS ON W. MAIN STREET:** C. Johnson stated that Lisa Minardi would give a presentation on the proposed Historic Walking Tour Brochure and proposed vertical banners on W. Main Street.

Lisa Minardi, President of The Speaker's House, gave a presentation about The Speaker's House role in protecting Trappe's historic treasures and buildings. L. Minardi spoke about the restoration of The Speaker's House and community outreach. L. Minardi stated that she is preparing a walking tour brochure that will include a map of the Trappe Borough Main Street historical buildings on one side and Collegeville Borough's on the other side. L. Minardi stated that she has received grant funding for the brochure and proposed vertical banners.


L. Minardi provided samples of the proposed banners for everyone to view. L. Minardi stated that the banner illustrations were done by renowned local artist Julie Longacre, and that they depict three of Trappe's most iconic historic buildings, The Speaker's House; Muhlenberg House; and Old Augustus Church. L. Minardi stated that each of the three banners is defined by a different color.

L. Minardi stated that the banners would be placed on approximately half of the poles along W. Main Street, staggered along both sides from Center Avenue to Cherry Avenue. L. Minardi stated that the exact placement of the banners has yet to be determined.
