Trappe Council Meeting Summary of Actions Taken May 1, 2018

- Trappe will be co-sponsoring a Recycling Day – “Anything with a Plug” from 9:00 AM to noon at Palmer Park, Skippack Township on May 5, 2018.
- Council approved a \$5,225 contract to repair two storm drain structures on Williams Way.
- The Borough received a Zoning Hearing Board application for the use of the former Getty Station on W. Main St. as a gas station with snack shop.
- Council approved a Comcast Audit/Review Settlement Agreement, which provides for the payment of \$15,999 to Trappe Borough in full settlement of all past Franchise Fee payment obligations. A similar review is ongoing with Verizon.
- A resident suggested a Parks and Recreation Committee be formed from community members to make suggestions regarding the maintenance of our three parks.
- Contingent upon Collegeville Council’s approval, Trappe Council approved a four-year contract with the bargaining unit at the Collegeville-Trappe Joint Public Works Department. The contract would become effective upon ratification by the union membership.
- Council approved the April 16, 2018 Borough Manager offer letter to Ms. Tamara Twardowski. Her start date is May 2, 2018. Council is looking forward to the addition of Tamara to our staff.
- Council thanked Borough Manager, Robert Umstead for his service to Trappe and wished him an enjoyable retirement.
- Council discussed the possible addition of lighting and security cameras to Waterworks Park. A lighting plan is to be provided to Council by the next meeting.
