ORDINANCE NO. 441

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 340-43 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF TRAPPE TO PERMIT THE GROWING, PROCESSING AND DISPENSING OF CROPS AS PROVIDED BY THE ACT OF APRIL 17, 2016, P.L. NO. 84, NO. 16.

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 340-43B of the Code of the Borough of Trappe is hereby amended to read as follows:

“B. Agriculture, including the growing and processing of crops by a grower/processor as defined and limited by and under the terms of the Act of April 17, 2016, P.L. 84, No. 16.”

SECTION 2. Section 340-43 of the Code of the Borough of Trappe is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

“E. The dispensing of substances by a dispensary as defined and limited by and under the terms of the Act of April 17, 2016, P.L. 84, No. 16.”

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any

Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.
