ORDINANCE NO. 452

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CERTAIN INTERMUNICIPAL
AGREEMENT REGARDING THE PURCHASE OF
MOTOROLA PORTABLE RADIOS AMONG TRAPPE
BOROUGH, UPPER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP, AND THE
TRAPPE FIRE COMPANY**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Trappe as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Trappe hereby adopts and directs appropriate Borough personnel to execute on its behalf a certain Intermunicipal Agreement regarding the purchase of Motorola portable radios and equipment by the Borough of Trappe and Upper Providence Township. Said Motorola portable radios and equipment will be used, maintained and insured by the Trappe Fire Company. Upon cessation of use by the Trappe Fire Company, the radios shall be delivered to the Borough of Trappe and Upper Providence Township for disposition.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.

Section 3. **Severability.** In the event that any section, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not prevent, preclude or otherwise foreclose enforcement of any of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the specific terms enacted hereby, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed.




