**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TRAPPE  
REPEALING ORDINANCE 358 REGARDING WATER  
RATES**

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the authority of same as follows:

**SECTION 1.** – Ordinance 358 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION 2.** – Chapter 326 §5 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Trappe is reaffirmed in its entirety and shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 3.** – Severability: The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

**SECTION 4. – Repealer:** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


**SECTION 5. – Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.


