ORDINANCE NO. 435

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 162, FIREARMS,
TO DELETE SECTION 162-2 THEREBY REMOVING
RESTRICTIONS OF POSSESSION OR CARRYING
FIREARMS ON BOROUGH PROPERTY**

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. The Code of the Borough of Trappe, Chapter 162 (Firearms) Section 162-2 (Restrictions on Possession or Carrying Firearms on Borough Property) is hereby amended to delete Section 162-2 in its entirety and restate said paragraph as “Reserved.”

SECTION 2. Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of the Borough of Trappe to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Borough of Trappe of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby

declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.
