A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF TRAPPE ADOPTING THE 2012 MONTGOMERY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, hazards including flooding periodically threaten the safety of people and result in property damage in Borough of Trappe; and

WHEREAS, the vulnerability of the Borough of Trappe to some hazard events may be reduced through various mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (Stafford Act), 42 U.S.C. 5165, enacted under paragraph 104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, provides new approaches to mitigation planning and requires local government to prepare and adopt mitigation plans as a condition for receiving certain federal disaster grants and loans and to update these plans each five years; and

WHEREAS, a Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared in 2007 and adopted by the county and Borough of Trappe; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 hazard mitigation plan has been prepared by the Montgomery County Planning Commission and Public Safety Department in accordance with appropriate federal guidelines established in accordance with the Stafford Act; and

WHEREAS, the public and the Borough of Trappe in the county was given an opportunity to fully participate in the preparation of the 2012 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan process; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Trappe hereby adopts the 2012 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Borough Manager is directed to formally submit a copy of this resolution to Montgomery County to be transmitted to Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to enable the plan's final approval.
