

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minute of February 27, 2015 were unanimously approved.

OLD SCHOOL NEW HOUSE CONDITIONAL USE:

At the time of the time of the meeting, the Borough had received reviews from Gilmore and Associates for the conditional use request (April 16), from Gilmore and Associates for the Land Development (April 15) and the Montgomery County Planning Commission (April 17). By a vote of 3-0, the Planning Commission voted to recommend the approval of the conditional use application. Land development plans will be resubmitted and reviewed at the July meeting.

LED Lighting Grant Application

Borough Council President, Nevin Scholl, provided the Planning Commission members with an update on the LED Lighting Grant Application. He stated that the Borough is looking to obtain grant funding for LED street light conversions. Mr. Scholl requested a recommendation from the Planning Commission to pursue the grant funding. The recommendation was approved by a vote of 3-0. A letter memorializing the recommendation will be submitted to Borough Council from the Planning Commission.

A motion was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting.
