**LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY DECLARATION FOR
TRAPPE BOROUGH DUE TO THE EFFECTS
OF THE COVID-19, CORONAVIRUS**

WHEREAS, PA Governor Wolf and the Montgomery County Commissioners have declared that the Coronavirus COVID-19 Pandemic is a threat anticipated to cause illness, suffering, and possible death to the persons of Trappe Borough, Montgomery County, and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 Pandemic could endanger the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing and working in Trappe Borough; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this illness and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of those residing and working in Trappe Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, we the undersigned official(s) of Trappe Borough, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Code (35PA C.S. Section 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Trappe Borough.


BE IF FURTHER DECLARED that we direct the Borough Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this Declaration.


BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that we authorize officials of Trappe Borough to act as necessary to meet the current demand of this emergency, namely by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the health and safety as may be required. All to be performed without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, excluding mandatory constitutional requirements. The officials of Trappe Borough are also authorized to apply for State and Federal Aid as it may be available as a result of this emergency, and to levy taxes and appropriate and expend public funds as may be necessary.

This Declaration of Emergency shall take effect immediately.


