RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 13

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PENNSYLVANIA MUTUAL
AID AGREEMENT FOR WATER/WASTEWATER PROVIDERS**

WHEREAS, Trappe Borough (“Trappe”) and Collegeville Borough (“Collegeville”) jointly own and operate a municipal water system through a committee of the boroughs (“Collegeville-Trappe Joint Public Works Committee”); and

WHEREAS, Collegeville-Trappe Joint Public Works Committee has recommended that the Boroughs approve the Pennsylvania Mutual Aid Agreement for Water/Wastewater Providers dated 2007, as amended and restated; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Mutual Aid Agreement for Water/Wastewater Providers provides for a sharing of resources among public and private water/wastewater providers in the event of an emergency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents of Trappe for Trappe Borough and Collegeville Borough through the Collegeville-Trappe Joint Public Works Committee to participate in the Pennsylvania Mutual Aid Agreement for Water/Wastewater Providers; and

WHEREAS, Collegeville Borough is considering approval of a similar Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the Borough Council of the Borough of Trappe authorizes the President of Borough Council or the proper officers of the Borough of Trappe to execute the Pennsylvania Mutual Aid Agreement for Water/Wastewater Providers as it will pertain to the Collegeville/Trappe municipal water system.


