ORDINANCE NO. 465

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TRAPPE,
COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTIONS 31-3 and 31-4 OF
THE BOROUGH CODE BY PROVIDING FOR THE
APPOINTMENT OF A FIRE MARSHAL AND THE
QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPENSATION OF THE FIRE
MARSHAL**

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-3 of the Trappe Borough Code shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 31-3. Appointment and Removal.

The Fire Marshal shall be appointed by the Borough Council of the Borough of Trappe and shall serve at the pleasure of the Borough Council. Fire Marshal may be an employee of the Borough, an independent contractor, or an employee of a neighboring municipality.

SECTION 2. Section 31-4 of the Trappe Borough Code shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 31-4. Qualification and Compensation.

The qualifications and compensation for the Borough Fire Marshal services shall be set forth in the agreement between the Borough and the Fire Marshal service provider which shall be approved by Ordinance or Resolution of the Borough Council from time-to-time as may be required by law.

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of

competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.


