ORDINANCE NO. 476

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TRAPPE, COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 300-57A OF THE BOROUGH CODE BY INCREASING THE FIRE TAX AND FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR 2024 AT 1.47 MILLS FOR EACH DOLLAR OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF REAL ESTATE

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 300-57A of the Trappe Borough Code shall be amended to read as follows:

In accordance with the Authority granted by Section 1302 of the Borough Code, 8 Pa. C.S.A. §1302, it is hereby levied for the calendar year commencing January 1, 2024 and each subsequent calendar year thereafter until further amended, a tax of 1.47 mills on each dollar of assessed value of real estate subject to taxation within the Borough of Trappe, to be used for the following purposes:

Purpose	Mills on Each Dollar of Assessed Value
Tax Rate for General Purposes	.47
Tax Rate for Fire Services	1.00

SECTION 2. Any ordinance or a part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections,

sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All other ordinaces or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2024 and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.
