ORDINANCE NO. 478

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF
TRAPPE CODE OF ORDINANCES PART 11, CHAPTER 1,
ARTICLE G, SECTION 11-1102.9 LOCAL LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the Lower Perkiomen Valley Regional Sewer Authority has adopted Resolution 2024-01, which has amended the limits to the point where wastewater is discharged to the sanitary sewer system (“local limits”); and

WHEREAS, the Lower Perkiomen Valley Regional Sewer Authority has requested that all Municipalities that are parties to the Inter-Jurisdictional Agreement dated August 11, 1993, amend their Code of Ordinances to conform the local limits as established by the Sewer Use Resolution 2024-01 of the Lower Perkiomen Valley Regional Sewer Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Trappe (“Borough”) desires to amend its Code of Ordinances, in specific, Part 11, Chapter 1, Article G, Section 11-1102.9, and in accordance with the Inter-Jurisdictional Agreement dated August 11, 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, Council of the Borough of Trappe does hereby ordain and enact the following:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances Part 11, Chapter 1, Article G, Section 11-1102.9 is amended to replace the chart of local limits, in its entirety, with the following:

<u>Parameter</u>	<u>Daily Maximum (mg/l)</u>
Arsenic	0.1
Cadmium	0.05
Chromium	3.5
Copper	1.0
Cyanide	1.0
Lead	0.8
Mercury	0.002
Nickel	1.1
Oil and grease and fats of animal or vegetable origin	100
Oil and grease of petroleum origin, non-biodegradable cutting oil, mineral oil	25
Silver	0.30
Zinc	2.4

SECTION 2. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 3. Repealer

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment.


