

**Minutes of the Meeting

Chairwoman Perlin called the Collegetville-Trappe Joint Public Works Department meeting to order on the above date at 7:12 PM. Members present were Mrs. McKinney, Mrs. Beckius, Mr. Farr, Mr. Strauss, Mr. Borrelli and Ms. Perlin. Also present were attorneys Rebecca Geiser of Kilkenny Law, LLC, and Dave Onorato of Hladik, Onorato & Federman, LLP, the engineer, Matt Boggs, of Entech Engineering and the Director, Joseph Hastings.

The members stood for the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

MINUTES:

Mrs. McKinney made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of April 22, 2025, as presented. Mrs. Beckius seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PUBLIC INPUT:

There was no public input.

ENGINEERING REPORT:

Mr. Boggs presented the Engineer's Report to the committee and is attached herewith.

There was no update on the Castle Cove project.

The engineer reported all items on the punchlist have been addressed for the Fugo Tract Development.

Mr. Boggs reported that the PFAS Treatment Options Report has been finalized. Hard copies have been provided. The EPA has announced it intends to extend compliance from the year 2029 to 2031.

The engineer reported that all the deliverables for the water modeling have been provided to the Director.

There was no update on the Bronson Circle Development.

The engineer reported that the easement and agreements have been sent to Mr. Onorato for legal review for the 56-62 Seventh Ave Development.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Strauss presented the Victory Bank's check register which is attached herewith. The beginning balance on the check register as of April 22, 2025, was \$192,131.32 deposits were \$215,966.28 and disbursements were \$205,702.63 leaving an ending balance of \$202,394.97 on May 20, 2025. Mr. Strauss motioned to approve check numbers 2259 through 2289, all EFTs and journal entries. Mrs. McKinney seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss motioned to purchase a 9 month PLGIT Term from the funds that matured on May 5th and a 12 month PLGIT Term from the funds that will mature on May 28th. Mrs. McKinney seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss reviewed the other financial reports which are attached herewith.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Mr. Hastings presented the Director's Report to the Committee and is attached herewith. The most recent PFOS and PFOA testing results were disseminated and are attached herewith.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Mr. Onorato reported that he is still waiting for verification of the settlement payment in the Class Action suit.

Mrs. McKinney made a motion to approve the Business Reports, which was seconded by Mrs. Beckius and the motion passed unanimously.
