RESOLUTION NO. 2026-08

**A RESOLUTION OF TRAPPE BOROUGH COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A POLICY GOVERNING
THE BROADCASTING OF PUBLIC MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, the Trappe Borough Council, seeking to increase public engagement and participation, has determined that it is in the best interests of the residents of Trappe Borough to broadcast all live public Council meetings via a virtual platform;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Trappe Borough Council as follows:

1. All Council meetings shall be broadcast to the public via a closed virtual platform. Public comment from persons not in attendance at a Council meeting may be submitted by hand-delivered mail or electronically by e-mail and must be received up to one day prior to each scheduled Council meeting.
2. Individuals engaging in public comment through mail or e-mail shall include their name and address with their comment. All public comment properly submitted pursuant to this Resolution shall be read and acknowledged during the regularly held public comment portion of Council meetings.
3. Recorded meetings shall be viewable during live meetings and will be retained for public view until the meeting minutes of each meeting are formally approved.
4. In the case of emergency, Councilmembers may attend Council meetings virtually, as prescribed under applicable laws, provided that a quorum of Council attends in-person.
5. In the event that the Council President attends a Council meeting virtually, the Council Vice President shall preside over the meeting, if the Vice President is present in-person. If both the President and Vice-President of Council do not attend a meeting in-person, the President pro Tempore shall preside.


