**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2026
ROUND OF THE MONTCO 2040 IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Montgomery County has established the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program as a competitive funding program to assist municipalities in implementing the goals of the county comprehensive plan, Montco 2040: *A Shared Vision*; and


WHEREAS, the County is accepting applications for projects that advance specific goals under either of the County Comprehensive Plan's three themes: Connecting Communities, Sustainable Places and a Vibrant Economy; and

WHEREAS, application and projects must meet all stated requirements within the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program Guidebook; and

WHEREAS, Collegetown and Trappe Boroughs wish to obtain \$350,000 from the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program to provide funding for a Joint Collegetown-Trappe Public Works project which will create a connection between the Borough's water system and the North Penn Water Authority. This project meets the specific goal of sustainable places by supporting modern infrastructure, and creating a vibrant economy by providing clean, safe, sufficient water for businesses and residents of Collegetown and Trappe Boroughs


