ORDINANCE NO. 480

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 315, ARTICLE III, SECTION 315-58 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO RESTRICT PARKING OF TRAILERS AND CAMPERS

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by Borough Council, Borough of Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the authority as same as follows:

SECTION 1. The Code of the Borough of Trappe, Section 315, Section 315-5. Schedule I-D: Special Permit Parking Zones, it is hereby amended by adding the following:

Street	Side	Between	Authorized Purpose of or vehicle
Williams Way	South	Entire Length	By permit only per the following <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Parking shall be by permit only available for the residents within the permit parking area of Rittenhouse Square, Hamilton Court and Bently Drive.2. Permits are available for passenger vehicles only and for trailers and campers when connected to a permitted vehicle and used in regular intervals.3. Any trailer or camper that remains parked for greater than seventy-two (72) hours shall be deemed in storge and in violation of the ordinance subject to enforcement.4. Permitted vehicle owners possessing a parked trailer or camper seeking to

			<p>request an extension beyond the seventy-two (72) hour time limit, due to time away on vacation or for vehicle malfunction, may do so by request made to the Borough office for a period not to exceed ten (10) business days.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Commercial vehicles and those larger than Class 2 vehicles or larger do not qualify for a permit. 6. Residents living in the permitted parking area shall be issued a permit for each qualified vehicle which is properly insured and which is registered to an address within the permit parking area; maximum of three (3) per household. 7. A resident of a property located within a permit parking zone may register his/her vehicle with Borough and be issued a parking permit to be displayed within the vehicle. 8. Proper identification, vehicle registration showing address of the applicant, Pennsylvania registration, valid insurance certificate and proof of residence within the permit parking area shall be submitted when making application. 9. Permitted vehicles must remain operational, unless requested limited waiver herein this provision is granted; 10. No repairs or maintenance to vehicles while parked on Williams Way. 11. All vehicles parked in violation of permit requirements may be towed at owner's expense.
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SECTION 2. Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of Borough of Trappe to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Borough of Trappe of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer


All other ordinances or parts of ordinances and any resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval as required by the law.
